### **Responsibilities:**

- **Financial operations:** Oversee assigned accounting functions, including the preparation of journal entries, maintenance of general ledgers, and reconciliation of balance sheet accounts for Head Office entities
- **Consolidation support:** Assist in the Group's consolidation process for quarterly, semi-annual and annual reporting cycles, ensuring data accuracy across diverse business units
- **Reporting & disclosure:** Prepare supporting schedules and assist in preparing financial statement notes for interim and annual Group reports in accordance with IFRS Accounting Standards
- **Budgeting & analysis:** Assist in the preparation of annual budgets and quarterly forecasts, providing preliminary variance analysis to identify key performance drivers
- **Compliance & research:** Support senior team members in researching new accounting standards and benchmarking the Group's financial presentation against prevailing market practices
- **Ad-hoc projects:** Participate in special projects, including audit coordination. Depending on progress and team commitments, the roles may cross-train in broader Group consolidation and preparation work

- Experience with Oracle, Hyperion, or similar ERP/consolidation systems is a distinct advantage
- Familiarity with graphical data presentation (e.g., Waterfall charts) is a plus
- High level of accuracy and a meticulous approach to work
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines under pressure
