Cheung Kong Group Contributed HK\$4 Million Donation in Celebration of the 10th Anniversary of Community Chest's Rainbow Fund

Last year, approximately HK\$12 million has been allocated to over 1,900 cases, supporting over 4,000 beneficiaries of the programme.

- Individuals and families with imminent needs threat to survival;
- Individuals and families with imminent needs otherwise causing irreversible damage and social consequences;
- Those marginalised in society, and those who are caught between gaps;
- Victims and survivors of accidents and natural disasters.
