

## **Cheung Kong Group Named One of Community Chest's Top 3 Donors for 15th Consecutive Year**

### **7 Group Members Received Individual Recognitions**

(June 16, 2014 – Hong Kong) At The Community Chest 2013/2014 Annual Presentation of Awards ceremony today, the Cheung Kong Group has earned the honour of being one of the top 3 donors for the 15th consecutive year.

At the awards presentation ceremony, an award was presented by Mrs Regina Leung, President of The Community Chest, to Mrs Wendy Tong Barnes, Chief Corporate Affairs Officer of Cheung Kong (Holdings) Limited (see photo 1).

In addition, seven members of the Cheung Kong Group have also received individual recognition for their contributions to The Community Chest: Cheung Kong (Holdings) Limited, Hutchison Whampoa Limited, Cheung Kong Infrastructure Holdings Limited, Power Assets Holdings Limited and HK Electric Investments Limited were presented with the President's Award; The Hongkong Electric Company Limited was presented with the Award of Excellence; while A. S. Watson Group was presented with the Award of Distinction (see photo 2).

In May 2014, a donation hotline was launched by the Group during the "Community for the Chest on TV" programme to raise money for The Community Chest's "Cheung Kong" Rainbow Fund. Over HK\$2.5 million was raised through the hotline by the public and matched dollar-for-dollar by the Cheung Kong Group. In celebration of the 10th anniversary of The Community Chest's Rainbow Fund, the Group decided to increase its matching contribution by over 60% to HK\$4 million, generating a total donation of over HK\$6.5 million.

During the year, members of the Cheung Kong Group had participated in a number of other fund-raising campaigns organized by The Community Chest. These included the Corporate and Employee Contribution Programme, Walk for Millions, Dress Special Day, The Community Chest Green Day and Skip Lunch Day.
